VALID 07:00 23.09.2024 TO 23:59 23.09.2024

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Monday 23rd: In the Northern region, morning thunderstorms are expected over parts Sokoto, Kebbi, Borno, Yobe, Bauchi, Jigawa, Gombe, Kano and Kaduna states. Later in the day thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa, Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe, Bauchi, Kano, Katsina, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kebbi and Sokoto states. Thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Benue, Plateau and Kwara states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Benue and Kogi states. Rains are envisaged over the Southwest inland especially parts of Oyo, Ondo, Osun, Ekiti and Ogun extending to the coastal states of Lagos, Delta, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Enugu, Edo, Ebonyi, Ondo, Abia, Osun, Imo, Ekiti, Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River, Rivers and Lagos states.

Advisory:

- i. High likelihood of urban flooding in major cities due to heavy downpours. Residents are advised to avoid flood-prone areas
- ii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iii. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- iv. Public and Airline operators are advised to get updated weather reports and forecast from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
