WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 09.11.2024 AND

VALID 00:00 10.11.2024 TO 23:59 12.11.2024

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Sunday 10th: In the Northern region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 - 5km is anticipated during the forecast hours. In the North Central region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 – 5km is expected during the forecast period. In the Southern region, sunny skies in hazy atmosphere are expected over the Inland, with prospects of thunderstorms with slight rains anticipated over parts of Lagos, Akwa Ibom and Cross River state in the morning. Towards the afternoon/evening hours thunderstorms with slight rains are expected over parts of souther Ondo, Ogun, Lagos, Edo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Rivers, and Delta states.

Monday 11th: In the Northern region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 - 5km is expected during the forecast hours. In the North Central region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 - 5km is expected during the forecast period. In the southern region, sunny and hazy skies are anticipated over the Inland while patches of clouds are expected over the Coastal states during the forecast period.

Tuesday 12th: In the Northern region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 - 5km is expected during the forecast hours. In the North Central region, slight dust haze with localized visibility of 2 – 5km is expected during the forecast period. In the southern region, sunny and hazy skies are anticipated over the Inland while patches of clouds are expected over the Coastal states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Lagos, Cross River, Rivers, Bayelsa, and Akwa Ibom states.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
