WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 20.01.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 21.01.2025 TO 23:59 23.01.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Tuesday 21st: Sunny skies in hazy atmosphere is expected over the Northern regions of the country throughout the forecast period. Hazy skies with patches of cloud are expected over the North Central and Inland cities of the Southern regions of the country with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms over parts of Ondo, Edo and Ogun states. In the Coastal regions of the South, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Rivers, Delta, Lagos, Cross Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states.

Wednesday 22nd: Slight dust haze is anticipated over the Northern regions of the country throughout the forecast period. Hazy skies with patches of cloud are expected over the North Central and Inland cities of the Southern regions of the country with throughout the forecast period. In the Coastal regions of the South, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms expected over parts of Rivers, Cross Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states.

Thursday 23rd: Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility of 2-5km is anticipated over the Northern regions of the country throughout the forecast period. Slight dust haze is anticipated over the North Central region of the country throughout the forecast period. Hazy skies with patches of cloud are expected over the Inland and Coastal cities of the Southern regions of the country with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms expected over parts of Rivers, Lagos, Delta, Cross Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
