WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 05.02.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 06.02.2025 TO 23:59 08.02.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Thursday 6th: In the Northern region, moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 - 5km is expected over parts of Jigawa, Borno, Yobe, Katsina and Kano states. While slight dust haze condition is anticipated over the remaining Northern states throughout the forecast period. In the North Central region, slight dust haze is expected during the forecast period. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Lagos, Bayelsa, Ogun, Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Ondo and Akwa Ibom states.

Friday 7th: Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 - 5km is expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period. Slight dust haze is expected over the North Central region during the forecast period. In the Southern region of the country, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Lagos, Edo, Ondo and Ogun state.

Saturday 8th: Moderate dust haze is anticipated over the Northern and North Central regions throughout the forecast period. In the Southern region of the country, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts Cross River, Rivers, Bayelsa, Delta and Akwa Ibom states.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.

- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
