FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Wednesday 2nd: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with chances of early morning thunderstorms over parts of southern Adamawa and Taraba states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the North Central region with chances of early morning thunderstorms over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Kogi and Nasarawa states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Kogi, Niger and Kwara states. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Lagos, Delta and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Thursday 3rd: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the North Central region with chances of early morning thunderstorms over parts of the Federal Capital Territory and Niger states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Benue, Kogi, Niger and Kwara states. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated with chances of thunderstorms over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Lagos, Delta and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Friday 4th: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms over parts of Taraba state. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the North Central region with prospect of afternoon/evening thunderstorms over parts of Benue, Kogi and Kwara

states. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Lagos, Delta and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Advisory:

- i. Temperatures are high over most parts of the country, putting people at risk of heat stress; people should stay in well-ventilated and cool spaces.
- ii. Drink plenty water to stay hydrated.
- iii. Get vaccinated against meningitis, practice good hygiene by washing hands regularly, avoid overcrowding in small spaces, use a nose mask to reduce chances of infection and avoid close contact with those affected.
- iv. Avoid peak sun hours (12pm – 3pm) and protect yourselves from undue exposure to direct sunlight.
- v. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- vi. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- vii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
