WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 03.04.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 04.04.2025 TO 23:59 06.04.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Friday 4th: Sunny skies with few patches of clouds are expected across the Northern region throughout the forecast period, except parts of Taraba state where isolated thunderstorms are anticipated in the afternoon/evening period. Sunny to partly cloudy skies are anticipated over the North Central region throughout the forecast period. Over the Southern region, isolated thunderstorms are expected parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Rivers states in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Edo, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Delta states.

Saturday 5th: Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region throughout the forecast period excluding parts of Taraba state where isolated thunderstorms are anticipated in the afternoon/evening period. Sunny skies with few clouds are expected across the North Central region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Niger, Benue, Kwara, Kogi, Nasarawa and the Federal capital territory during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Cross River states. In the afternoon/evening hours, localized thunderstorms are likely over parts of Oyo, Osun, Ogun, Ekiti, Ondo, Edo, Lagos, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Delta states.

Sunday 6th: Sunny skies are expected across the Northern region throughout the forecast period. Sunny skies with few clouds are expected across the North Central region throughout the forecast period. In the South, further cloud coverage is anticipated during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River state. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are

expected over parts of Edo, Ondo, Abia, Imo, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta, Rivers and Bayelsa states.

Advisory:

- i. Temperatures are high over most parts of the country, putting people at risk of heat stress; people should stay in well-ventilated and cool spaces.
- ii. Drink plenty water to stay hydrated.
- iii. Get vaccinated against meningitis, practice good hygiene by washing hands regularly, avoid overcrowding in small spaces, use a nose mask to reduce chances of infection and avoid close contact with those affected.
- iv. Avoid peak sun hours (12pm – 3pm) and protect yourselves from undue exposure to direct sunlight.
- v. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
