WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 12.04.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 13.04.2025 TO 23:59 15.04.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Sunday 13th: Moderate Dust Haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 – 5km is anticipated over the North except for Taraba, Adamawa and Kebbi states where partly cloudy skies are expected within the forecast period. In the North central region partly cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals are expected alongside prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kwara, Kogi and Benue states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with chances of isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ogun, Ondo, Oyo, Edo, Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Delta and Lagos states.

Monday 14th: Sunny skies are expected across the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna, Taraba and Kebbi states during the afternoon/evening hours. Sunny skies with few clouds are expected across the North Central region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kogi, Niger, Federal Capital Territory, Plateau and Benue states in the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are anticipated with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Cross River states. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Osun, Ogun, Ondo, Edo, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Lagos, Rivers and Delta states.

Tuesday 15th: Sunny skies are expected across the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna, Taraba Adamawa and Kebbi states during the afternoon/evening hours. Sunny skies with few clouds are expected across the North Central region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Niger, Benue, Kwara, Kogi, Nasarawa and the Federal

Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours. In the South morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Delta, River, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Ogun, Oyo, Osun, Ondo, Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Anambra, Lagos, Edo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta, Rivers and Bayelsa states.

Advisory:

- i. Temperatures are high over most parts of the country, putting people at risk of heat stress; people should stay in well-ventilated and cool spaces.
- ii. Drink plenty water to stay hydrated.
- iii. Get vaccinated against meningitis, practice good hygiene by washing hands regularly, avoid overcrowding in small spaces, use a nose mask to reduce chances of infection and avoid close contact with those affected.
- iv. Avoid peak sun hours (12pm 3pm) and protect yourselves from undue exposure to direct sunlight.
- v. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
