REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) is expected to be weak over the West African region. Good moisture influx and velocity potential are expected to enhance the prospects of Heavy rainfall over parts of Southern Taraba, Bayelsa, Enugu, Anambra, Rivers, Imo, Abia, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Heavy to Moderate rainfall over parts of Southern Taraba, Southern Adamawa, Kaduna, Bayelsa, Enugu, Anambra, Rivers, Imo, Abia, Akwa Ibom, Enugu, Ebonyi, Benue, Oyo, Ogun, Lagos, Ondo, Edo, and Delta states. Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Niger, Kaduna, the Federal capital Territory, Plateau, Kogi, and Ekiti states. Low to Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Nasarawa, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Niger, Kwara, Bauchi, plateau, Sokoto, Zamfara, Kano, Katsina and Cross River states while low rainfall is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

Advisory: There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions: do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.

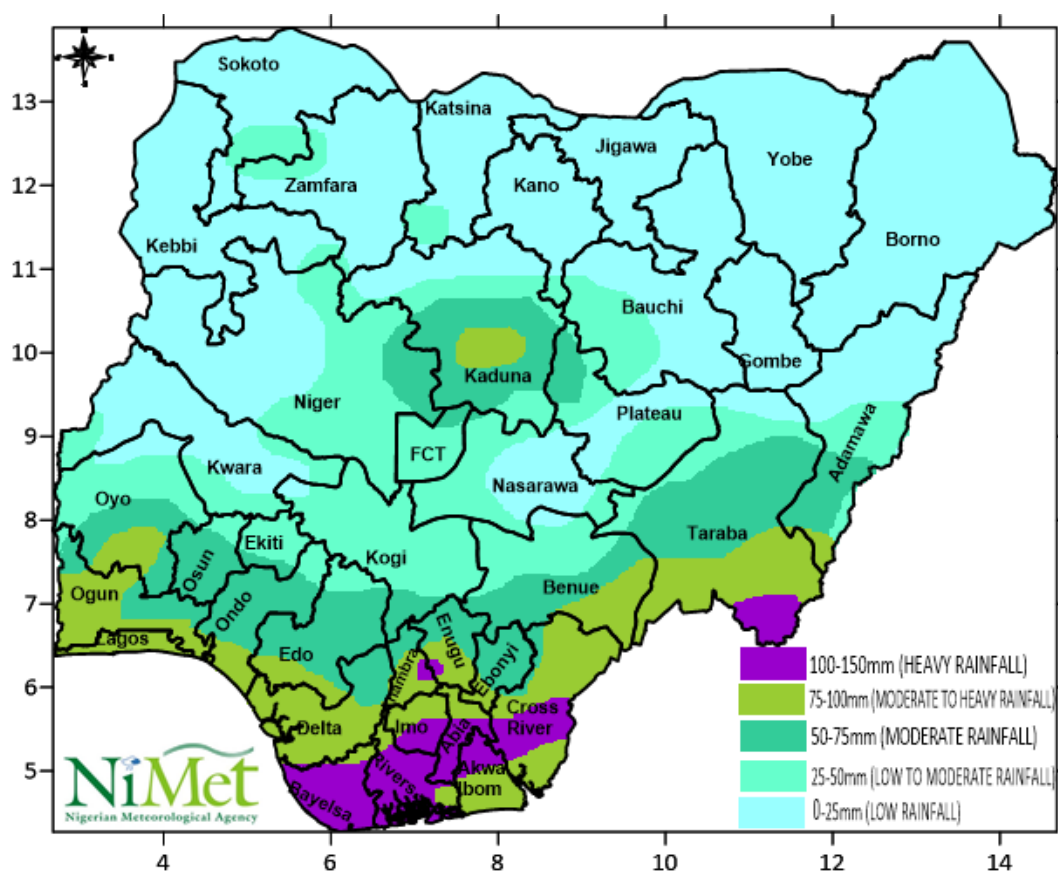


FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

2.1 Maximum Temperature

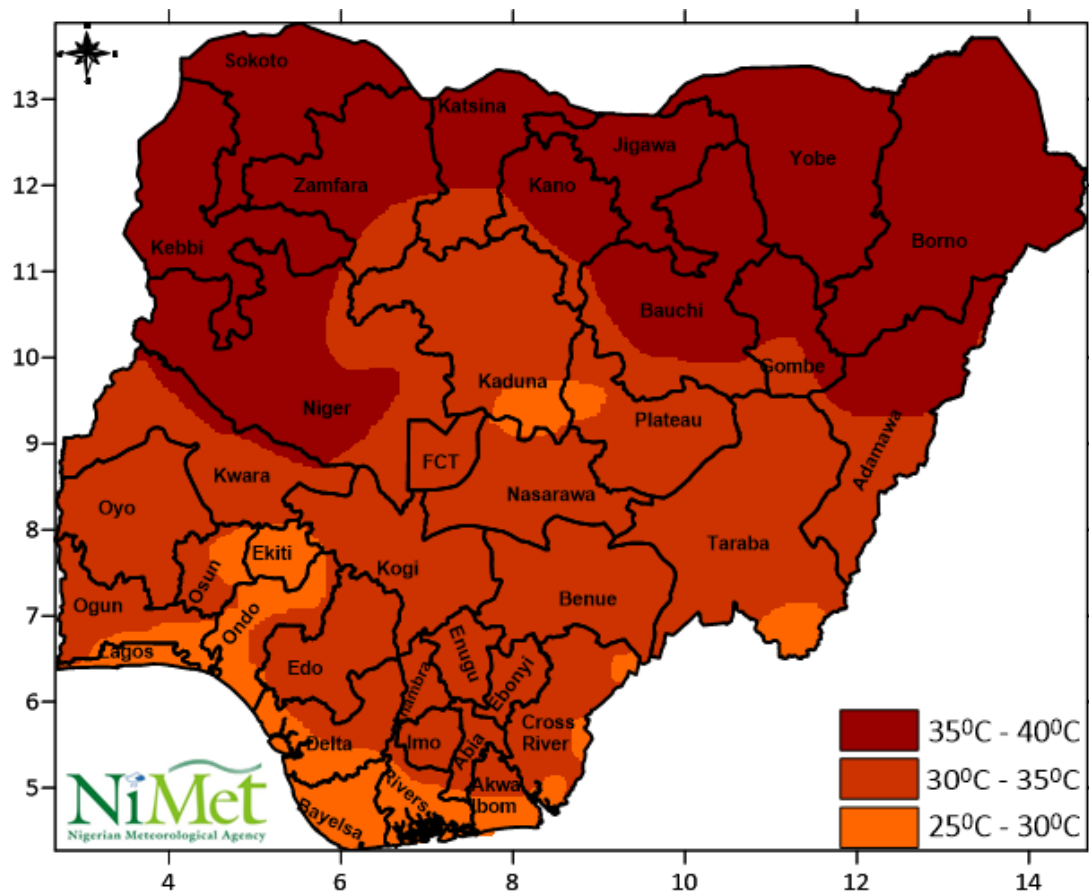


FIGURE 2: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Maximum Temperature range between 35 – 40°C is expected over Borno, Yobe, Jigawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, parts of Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Bauchi, Gombe, Niger, Kwara and Adamawa states. Temperature range between 25 – 30°C is expected over Ekiti, Lagos, Bayelsa, Parts of Kaduna, Plateau, Nasarawa, Ogun, Osun, Ondo, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Temperature range 30 – 35°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country (See Figure 2).

2.2 Minimum Temperature

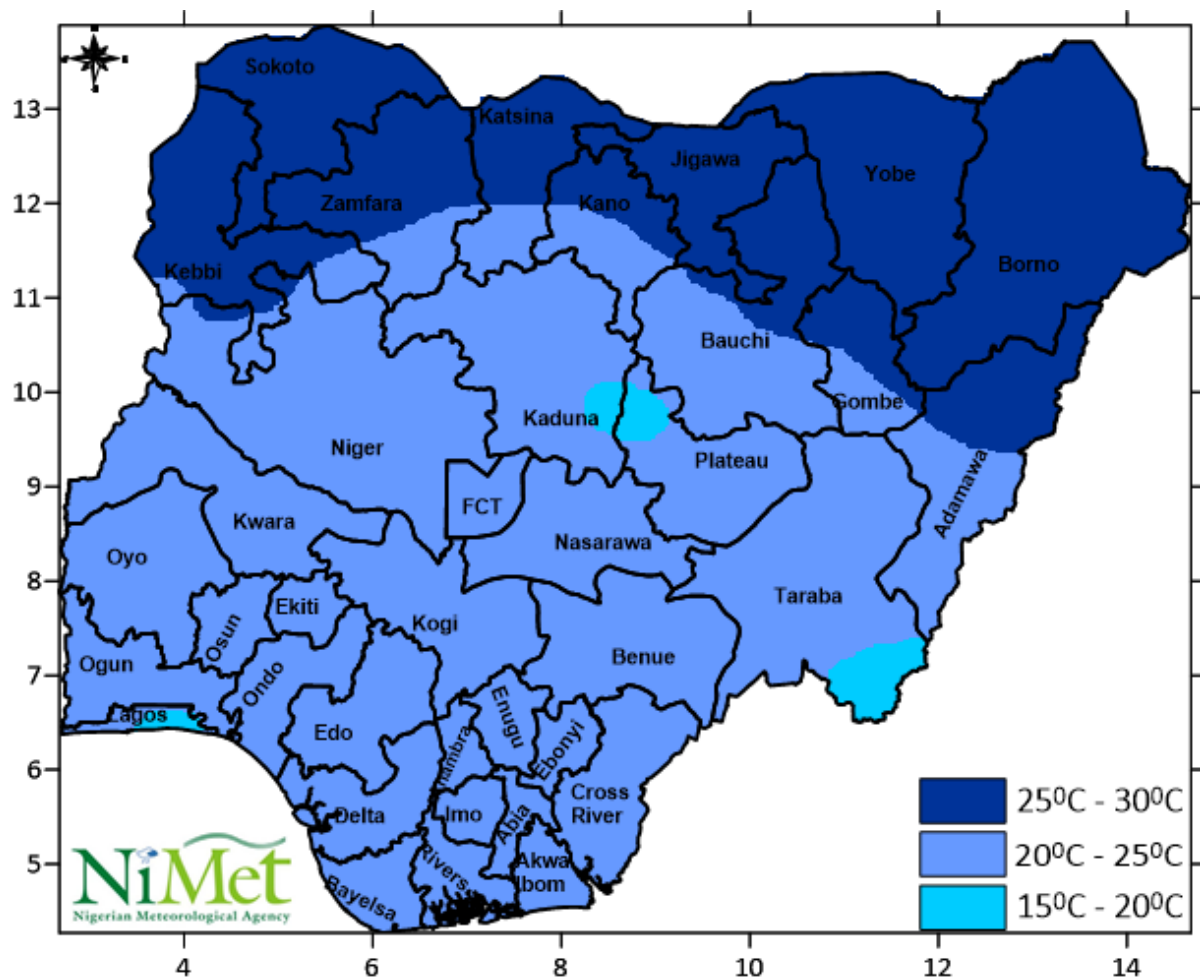


FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Minimum Temperature below 20°C is expected over parts of Kaduna, Lagos, Plateau and Sothern Taraba states. Minimum temperature range of 25 - 30°C is expected over Sokoto, Jigawa, Yobe, Borno, parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Bauchi, Gombe and Adamawa States. Temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country (See Figure 3).
