FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Saturday 14th: In the Northern region, early morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba, Kebbi, Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Bauchi, Kaduna and Adamawa states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Kebbi, Taraba, Zamfara, Borno, Kaduna, Sokoto, Gombe and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, early morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Benue, Plateau, Niger, Kogi, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Benue, Kwara, Kogi and Plateau states. In the Southern region, Morning rains expected over parts of Enugu, Ebonyi, Edo, Ondo, Ekiti, Osun, Imo, Abia, Cross River, Lagos, Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Imo, Enugu, Abia, Ebonyi, Anambra, Ondo, Oyo, Osun, Ogun, Ekiti, Edo, Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Rivers State.

Sunday 15th: In the Northern region, prospects of morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kaduna, Kebbi, Adamawa and Taraba states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Kebbi, Kaduna, Zamfara, Gombe and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are expected with prospects of early morning thunderstorms to affect parts of Kogi, Kwara, Plateau, Niger, Nasarawa, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Benue and Plateau states. In the Southern region, Morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Delta, Lagos, Rivers, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over most parts of Imo, Enugu, Abia,

Ebonyi, Anambra, Ondo, Oyo, Ogun, Ekiti, Edo, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta, Bayelsa and Rivers State.

Monday 16th: In the Northern region, prospects of morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Kano, Katsina, Kebbi, Zamfara, Gombe, Kaduna and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are expected with prospects of thunderstorms with rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Benue, Kogi and Niger states. Thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kwara, Plateau, Nasarawa, Niger, Benue and Kogi states in afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, cloudy atmosphere is expected with chances of morning rains over parts of Ogun, Edo, Ondo, Ogun, Delta and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

Advisory:

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
