



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Sunday 22nd June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with rains are anticipated during the early morning hours over parts of Taraba, Kebbi, Kaduna, Adamawa and Bauchi states while the rest of the region will be sunny with patches of cloud. Isolated thunderstorms (with or without rains) are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Gombe, Bauchi, Kano, Katsina, Taraba, Adamawa, Kebbi, Sokoto, Borno, Yobe, Jigawa and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Chances of early morning thunderstorms (with moderate rains) are expected over parts of Benue, Nasarawa, Niger, Plateau and the Federal Capital Territory while the rest of the region is expected to be sunny with cloud patches. Isolated thunderstorms (with or without rain) are expected over parts of Plateau, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Benue, Nasarawa and Niger states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross river, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Afternoon/evening isolated thunderstorms with light to moderate rain are expected over parts of Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Edo, Ondo, Ogun, Oyo, Delta, Lagos, Rivers, Bayelsa, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Monday 23rd June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated in most of the region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains expected over parts of Adamawa, Kaduna and Taraba states. Thunderstorms with moderate rain are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Kano, Katsina, Kaduna, Sokoto, Zamfara, Kebbi, Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe, and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts Benue, Plateau and Kogi states. Afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are anticipated across the North central region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross river, Akwa Ibom, Lagos, Ogun, Ondo and Edo states. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Day 3: Tuesday 24th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Taraba, Kebbi and Adamawa states while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rain showers are expected over Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe, Bauchi, Zamfara, Kebbi, Kano, Katsina, Sokoto and Kaduna states during the late afternoon to evening/night periods.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts Niger state during the morning hours. Scattered thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected across the region in the afternoon to evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of morning rains over Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
