



## Weather Outlook

### Day 1: Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2025

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the region with chances of early morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains over parts of Yobe, Jigawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi and Taraba states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, these rains are expected to continue over parts of Borno, Jigawa, Yobe, Gombe, Bauchi, Kaduna, Katsina and Kano states.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Niger states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening periods moderate rains are anticipated over this region.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.*

## Day 2: Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Yobe, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Taraba and Bauchi states. Cloudy skies are expected with chances of Light rains over parts of Bauchi, Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **Central Region:**

*Early morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kwara, Nasarawa, Niger, Kogi, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory and Plateau state. Cloudy skies are expected with prospects of Light rains over parts of Nasarawa, Kwara, Benue, Kogi and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **Southern Region:**

*Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Ebonyi, Oyo, Imo, Osun, Ondo, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains are expected over this region during the afternoon/evening hours.*

## Day 3: Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara and Sokoto states while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches. Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening periods.*

### **Central Region:**

*Cloudy skies with sunshine intervals are expected over this region during the morning hours with chances of light rains over Niger state. Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Niger, Kogi, Benue, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening periods.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over this region with chances of morning rains over parts of Delta, Edo, Ondo, Ekiti, Osun, Oyo, Ogun and Lagos states. Moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.*

**Advisory**

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
