

Weather Outlook

Day 1: Wednesday 2nd July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the region with chances of early morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains over parts of Zamfara, Adamawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi and Taraba states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, these rains are expected to continue over this region.

Central Region:

Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Benue and Niger states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening these rains are anticipated to continue over this region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross River, Lagos, Bayelsa and Akwa Ibom states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are expected over parts of this region.

Day 2: Thursday 3rd July, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Yobe, Borno, Jigawa, Gombe, Sokoto, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano, Katsina, Taraba and Bauchi states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours the rains are expected to continue over this region.

Central Region:

Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Nasarawa, Niger, Kogi and Benue states. Cloudy skies are expected with prospects of Light rains over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa, Benue, Kogi and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Ebonyi, Oyo, Imo, Osun, Ondo, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains are expected over this region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Friday 4th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Kano, Taraba, Adamawa and Sokoto states while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches. Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of this region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with sunshine intervals are expected over this region during the morning hours with chances of light rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Nasarawa and Niger states. Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of this region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region with chances of morning rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Delta, Edo, Ondo, Ekiti, Osun, Oyo, Ogun and Lagos states. Moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
