



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Friday 4th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with rains are anticipated during the early morning hours over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Sokoto, Zamfara, Kebbi and Borno states, while the rest of the region will be sunny with patches of cloud. Isolated thunderstorms with rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Adamawa, Taraba and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Chances of early morning thunderstorms with rains are expected over parts of Benue, Nasarawa, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kwara states while the rest of the region is expected to be sunny with cloud patches. Isolated thunderstorms (with or without rain) are expected over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Benue states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region with prospects of morning light rains over parts of Bayelsa, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Afternoon/evening isolated light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Ogun, Lagos, Ekiti, Ondo, Osun, Oyo, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Saturday 5th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected in most parts of the region during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rain are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Bauchi, Gombe, Yobe, Sokoto, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory. Afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Plateau states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers and Bayelsa states. Moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Coastal cities during the afternoon/evening periods.

Day 3: Sunday 6th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the Northern regions with prospects of morning thunderstorms with rains over parts of Taraba, Sokoto, Zamfara and Kebbi states. Thunderstorms with heavy rains are expected over the entire region during the early afternoon to evening/night periods.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Scattered thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kwara, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi states during the afternoon to evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of morning rains over parts of Rivers, Cross River and Bayelsa states during the morning hours, while the remaining parts are expected to be under cloudy skies. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
