Day 1: Sunday 27th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches are expected over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with light to moderate rains anticipated over parts of Jigawa, Kano, Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi and Yobe states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the entire region. There is high possibility of flash flood occurring over parts of Kaduna and Kebbi states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of morning light to moderate rains over parts of Niger, Benue, Kogi, Plateau, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa state. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, moderate to heavy rains are anticipated over the most parts of the region with high possibility of flash flood occurring over parts of Niger state and western parts of the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Moderate to heavy rains are expected over parts of Enugu, Edo, Ebonyi, Anambra, Ondo, Imo, Abia, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours. There is high possibility of flash flood occurring over parts of Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom during the forecast period.

Day 2: Monday 28th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms

with moderate rains expected over parts of Kaduna, Gombe, Borno, Yobe, Bauchi, Sokoto and Jigawa

states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over

the entire region.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated over the region with chances of Light to moderate

rains anticipated over parts of Plateau, Kwara, Niger, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi state

during the morning hours. In the Afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are anticipated over most

parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Cross River and

Rivers states. Later in the day, Moderate to heavy rains are expected over most parts of region. There is

high possibility of flash flood occurring over parts of Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom

during the forecast period.

Day 3: Tuesday 29th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the Northern regions with chances of early morning

thunderstorms with rains over Tarab, Kebbi and Kaduna states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are

expected over parts of Bauchi, Sokoto, Jigawa, Kebbi, Kaduna and Taraba states in the afternoon/evening

hours.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated over the region with chances of light rains over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau and Kogi states during the morning hours.

Moderate rains are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Benue, Kogi and Plateau states during the afternoon to evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of Moderate to heavy rains expected over parts of Anambra, Abia, Ondo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Edo, Imo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening periods. There is high possibility of flash flood occurring over parts of Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom during the forecast period.

Advisory

- i. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should active emergency response system, immediately.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Ensure warm clothing for the vulnerable persons due to low night-time temperatures.
- iv. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- v. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- vi. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
