### Day 1: Thursday 31<sup>ST</sup> July, 2025

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with light to moderate rains over parts of Borno, Yobe, Adamawa, Zamfara, Kebbi, Kaduna, Taraba, Bauchi and Katsina states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire region.*

#### **Central Region:**

*There are chances of light to moderate rains over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa state during the morning hours. During the afternoon/evening hours, light to moderate rains is anticipated over parts of Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Plateau, Niger, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of light to moderate rains over parts of Enugu, Ebonyi and Cross River states during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains is expected over parts of Ekiti, Oyo, Ondo, Abia, Imo, Ebony, Enugu, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

## Day 2: Friday 1<sup>ST</sup> August, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Jigawa, Kaduna, Gombe and Bauchi states. Later in the afternoon to evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Gombe, Kebbi, Sokoto, Zamfara, Katsina, Jigawa, Yobe, Adamawa, Taraba, Kano and Bauchi states.*

### **Central Region:**

*There are chances of light to moderate rains over parts of Plateau, Kwara, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. During the afternoon/evening hours, light to moderate rains is anticipated over parts of Kogi, Plateau, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.*

### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of light to moderate rains which is expected to affect parts of Abia, Ebonyi, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains is expected over parts of Ondo, Imo, Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom during the afternoon/evening hours.*

## Day 3: Saturday 2<sup>ND</sup> August, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kaduna and Adamawa states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over Adamawa, Taraba, Bauchi, and Kaduna states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **Central Region:**

*Light to moderate rains is anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory and Niger states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa, the Federal Capital Territory, Benue and Niger states*

### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies with intermittent light to moderate rains are expected over the South east and the South South region during the morning hours. Later in the day, light to moderate rain is expected over parts of Ebonyi, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Delta and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.*
