Day 1: Friday 1st August, 2025

Northern Region:

There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Katsina, Sokoto, Kebbi, Kano, Kaduna, Borno, Gombe, Bauchi and Jigawa states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over Adamawa, Yobe, Katsina, Zamfara, Kebbi, Kano, Kaduna, Gombe and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

There are chances of light rains over parts of Benue, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. During the afternoon/evening hours, light rains are anticipated over parts of Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Plateau, Niger, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of light rains which is expected to affect parts of Abia, Enugu, Ebonyi, Cross River and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. Light rains are expected over parts of Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Osun, Ogun, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Saturday 2nd July, 2025

Northern Region:

There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Jigawa, Kaduna, Gombe and Bauchi states. Later during the afternoon to evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Gombe, Kaduna, Adamawa, Taraba and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

There are chances of light rains over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Kwara states during the morning hours. During the afternoon/evening hours, light rains are anticipated over parts of Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Plateau, Niger, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of light rains which is expected to affect parts of Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Light rains are expected over parts of Abia, Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Sunday 3rd August, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Taraba, Kaduna and Adamawa states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kaduna, Kano, Bauchi, Adamawa and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening hours.

There are chances of flash flooding over parts of Taraba state during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Light rains are anticipated over most parts of Nasarawa and Benue states in the morning hours. During the afternoon/evening hours, light rains are anticipated over parts of Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Plateau, Niger, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies with intermittent light rains are expected over parts of Ebonyi Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Edo, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Delta and Cross River states throughout the forecast period.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
 - ii. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should active emergency response system, immediately.
 - iii. Ensure warm clothing for the vulnerable persons due to low night-time temperatures.
 - iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
 - v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
 - v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
 - vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
