Day 1: Wednesday 13th August, 2025

Northern Region:

There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains in parts of Borno, Adamawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, Gombe, Bauchi, Yobe, Jigawa and Taraba states. Later during the afternoon to evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected in parts of Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, Yobe, Gombe, Bauchi, Borno, Kaduna, Kano, Jigawa, Taraba and Adamawa states. There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of Sokoto, Kebbi, Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe and Bauchi during the forecast period.

Central Region:

There are prospects of light rains in parts of Plateau, Niger, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory and Niger states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Niger, Nasarawa and Kwara States

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of light rains in parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, moderate rains are expected over the entire region.

Day 2: Thursday 14th August, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated in parts of Bauchi, Gombe, Kano, Taraba, Adamawa, Kaduna, Katsina, Sokoto and Zamfara states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire region during the afternoon/evening hours. There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of Bauchi, Gombe, Kaduna and Kano states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

There are prospects of intermittent light rains in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Benue and Kogi states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening period, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Benue and Kogi states during the morning period There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Territory, Nasarawa, Niger and Plateau states during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of light rains to affect parts of Oyo, Ogun, Ondo, Ekiti, Osun, Edo and Lagos states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, the rains are expected to continue over most part of the region.

Day 3: Friday 15th August, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated in parts of Katsina, Kano, Kaduna, Borno, Jigawa, Yobe, Zamfara and Sokoto states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire region during the afternoon/evening hours. There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of Yobe, Jigawa, Bauchi, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Kebbi and Sokoto states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Light rains are anticipated in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Niger, Plateau and Kogi states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over the entire region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy morning should persist over the entire region with prospects of intermittent rains over the entire region during the afternoon/evening period.

Advisory

- Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should activate emergency response system, immediately.
- iii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iv. Ensure warm clothing for the vulnerable persons due to low night-time temperatures.
- v. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- vi. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
