Day 1: Friday 29th August, 2025

Northern Region:

There are prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Gombe, Bauchi, Adamawa and Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kano, Kaduna, Kebbi, Katsina, Gombe, Bauchi, Adamawa, Yobe, Taraba and Borno states.

Central Region:

There are prospects of light rains over Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Kogi, Nasarawa and Plateau states within the morning hours. Later in the day, light rains are envisaged over parts of Nasarawa, Benue, Kwara, Niger, Plateau and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the Southern region with chances of light rains over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening period, intermittent light rains are anticipated over parts of Ondo, Edo, Abia, Imo, Oyo, Anambra, Enugu, Ogun, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta and Bayelsa states

Day 2: Saturday 30th August, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kaduna, Gombe, Kebbi and Bauchi states during the morning hours. During the afternoon to evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate

rains are expected over parts of Kano, Katsina, Kebbi, Borno, Yobe, Bauchi, Kaduna, Sokoto, Adamawa, Taraba and Zamfara states.

Central Region:

There are prospects of light rains over parts of Nasarawa, Niger, Kwara, Benue and Plateau states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Niger and Nasarawa states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Ebonyi, Oyo, Ogun, Ondo, Enugu and Edo states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, intermittent light rains are expected over parts of Ogun, Oyo, Edo, Delta Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 3: Sunday 31st August, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Kebbi, Taraba, Jigawa and Adamawa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Taraba, Kaduna, Bauchi, Zamfara, Yobe, Jigawa and Borno states. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Borno, Adamawa and Yobe states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies are expected with chances of light rains over parts of Niger and Plateau states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, intermittent light rains are anticipated over parts of Niger, Plateau and Kwara states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region during the forecast period.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure warm clothing for the vulnerable persons due to low night-time temperatures.
- iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
