



WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST BULLETIN No: 202509017 ISSUED ON: 2nd September, 2025

Valid: From 2nd September, 2025 to 8th September, 2025.

REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) is expected to be weak over the West African region. Good moisture influx, velocity potential, lower level convergence and upper level divergence are expected to enhance prospects of **Heavy rainfall** over parts of Plateau, Kano, Katsina, Bauchi, Nasarawa, Taraba, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. **Moderate to Heavy rainfall** is expected over parts of Borno, Zamfara, Yobe, Katsina, Kano, Bauchi, Kaduna, Kebbi, Adamawa, Kwara, Niger, Plateau, Nasarawa, FCT, Kogi, Benue, Abia, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Taraba states. **Moderate rainfall** is expected over parts of Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, Borno, Adamawa, Taraba, Niger, Plateau, Kogi, Kwara, Oyo, Ekiti, Anambra, Imo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Abia, Benue, Taraba, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. **Low to Moderate** rainfall is expected over parts of Sokoto, Yobe, Borno, Kwara, Oyo, Osun, Ondo, Edo, Delta and Bayelsa, while **Low rainfall** is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

Advisory

The rains are expected to be accompanied by strong winds which can disrupt traffic, pull down weak and make-shift structures. Lightning strikes and thunderbolts are also expected to be quite active. Hence, the public is advised to exercise restraint; disconnect electrical appliances just before the rains and not during, avoid parking vehicles under trees during the storm, and wait for the storm to pass before driving.




Figure 1: Spatial distribution of anticipated rainfall

2.1 <u>Maximum Temperature</u>




Figure 2: Spatial distribution of maximum temperature forecast

Maximum temperature ranges of $30 - 35^{\circ}$ C are expected in parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa, Bauchi, Gombe, Kano, Katsina, Sokoto and Kebbi states. Temperature ranges of $20 - 25^{\circ}$ C are expected in parts of Taraba, Plateau and Kaduna states during the week. Temperature ranges of $25 - 30^{\circ}$ C are expected over the rest of the country. (See Figure 2).

2.2 <u>Minimum Temperature</u>




Figure 3: Spatial distribution of minimum temperature forecast

Minimum temperature ranges of 15 - 20°C are expected in parts of Bauchi, Adamawa, Taraba, Plateau, Kaduna and Kano states. Temperature range of 25 - 30°C is expected over Yobe and Borno states. The rest of the country will be within the range of 20-25°C. (See Figure 3).
