



## Weather Outlook

### Day 1: Thursday 25th September, 2025.

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with prospects of Isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Taraba, Zamfara, Kaduna, Kano, Bauchi, Gombe and Adamawa states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Jigawa, Borno, Yobe, Kaduna, Kano, Bauchi, Adamawa and Taraba states.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Benue, Plateau, Niger, Kwara and Kogi states.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Cross River states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the region.*

### Day 2: Friday 26th September, 2025.

#### **Northern Region:**

*There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Bauchi, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Taraba and Kaduna states, while cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine should prevail over the remaining parts of the North during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms*

*with moderate rains are expected over parts of Sokoto, Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Kaduna and the North eastern region.*

**Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of thunderstorms and Light rains over parts of Benue, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kwara and Niger states.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are envisaged over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Ogun, Oyo, Ondo, Ekiti, Bayelsa, Edo Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states.*

**Day 3: Saturday 27th September, 2025.**

---

**Northern Region:**

*There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Kaduna, Taraba, and Adamawa states, while cloudy skies should prevail over the remaining parts of the region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Zamfara and Sokoto states.*

**Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of thunderstorms and light rains over parts of Niger, Nasarawa and Benue states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over the entire region.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are envisaged over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Abia, Ebonyi, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the entire region.*

### **Advisory**

---

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
