

# **Weather Outlook**

Day 1: Friday 26th September, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Sokoto, Zamfara, Kebbi, Katsina, Kaduna, Kano, Bauchi, Gombe and Taraba states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kaduna and Taraba states.

### **Central Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Benue and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Niger, Kwara and the Federal Capital Territory.

## **Southern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Oyo, Ogun, Lagos and Cross River states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the region.

Day 2: Saturday 27th September, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Adamawa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Zamfara, Kaduna, Gombe and Adamawa states.

## **Central Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Benue, Niger and Kwara states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kwara, Koqi, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory and Niger states.

#### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are envisaged over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Oyo, Ondo, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Rivers, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the region.

# Day 3: Sunday 28th September, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over region with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Adamawa, Kaduna and Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna and Bauchi states.

## **Central Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi and Benue states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Benue, Plateau, Kogi and Nasarawa states.

#### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are envisaged over the region with prospects of light rains over parts of Edo, Ondo, Abia, Ebonyi, Anambra, Enugu, Imo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the entire region.

# There are prospects of Flooding over parts of Benue, Taraba and Cross River states.

# **Advisory**

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should activate emergency response plans, immediately.
- iii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
