Day 1: Saturday 27th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Yobe, Jigawa, Gombe, Bauchi, Kano, Kaduna, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto and Kebbi states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Niger, Kwara, Benue, Kogi, Plateau, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region with prospects of intermittent rains over parts of Oyo, Ogun, Ondo, Lagos, Edo, Delta and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over most part of the region.

Day 2: Sunday 28th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Adamawa states. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kaduna, Kebbi, Taraba and Adamawa states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Benue, Nasarawa, Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kwara, Kogi, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Plateau and Niger states.

Southern Region:

Thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over this region throughout the forecast period.

There are prospects of Flooding over parts of Anambra, Delta, Lagos, Ogun, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Cross River states.

Day 3: Monday 29th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Zamfara, Sokoto and Kebbi states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over this region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi and Kwara states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Benue, Plateau, Kogi, Niger, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Nasarawa states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are envisaged over the during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over most part of the region.

Advisory

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should activate emergency response plans, immediately.
- iii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
