



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Wednesday 1st October, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rainfall over parts of Taraba and Southern Adamawa states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening periods, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Southern Adamawa, Southern Zamfara, Southern Kaduna, Southern Bauchi, Kebbi, Southern Gombe and Taraba states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the central region with chances of early morning isolated thunderstorm with rains over parts of Niger, Kogi, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara and Nasarawa states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the southern region with prospects of intermittent rains over parts of Edo, Lagos, Delta, Ogun, Ondo, Enugu, Imo, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are envisaged over the region.

There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Ebonyi, Cross river, Akwa Ibom, Enugu, Imo and Abia state.

Day 2: Thursday 2nd October, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rainfall over parts of Southern Adamawa and Taraba states during the morning periods. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Southern Gombe, Southern Kaduna, Southern Borno, Katsina, Kano, Southern Zamfara, Taraba, Southern Adamawa, Kebbi, Sokoto, and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected to prevail with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kwara states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the southern region with prospects of intermittent rains over parts of Oyo, Ogun, Ondo, Osun, Imo, Ebonyi, Anambra, Enugu, Abia, Edo, Rivers, Delta, Bayelsa, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over the region.

Day 3: Friday 3rd October, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region during the morning periods. In the afternoon/evening periods, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Southern Borno, Kebbi, Taraba, Adamawa and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the central region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are envisaged over the southern region with prospects of intermittent rains over parts of Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta and Lagos states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over most part of the region.



Advisory

- i. Possibility of flash flood is high so states should activate emergency response plans, immediately.
- ii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
