REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) signal is expected to stay weak over the West African region. However, good moisture influx and favourable 200hPa velocity potential anomaly are expected to enhance the prospects of **Heavy rainfall** over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. **Moderate to Heavy rainfall** is expected over parts of Sokoto, Katsina, Kaduna, Adamawa, Taraba, Niger, FCT, Plateau, Nasarawa, Ondo, Lagos, Edo and Delta states. **Moderate rainfall** is expected over parts of Yobe, Jigawa, Kano, Gombe, Zamfara, Kebbi, Kwara, Kogi, Benue, Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Anambra, Ekiti, Osun, Oyo, Ogun, Bayelsa and Rivers states. **Low to Moderate** rainfall is expected over parts of Borno, Yobe, Zamfara, Kebbi and Oyo while **Low rainfall** is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

Advisory: There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions; do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.

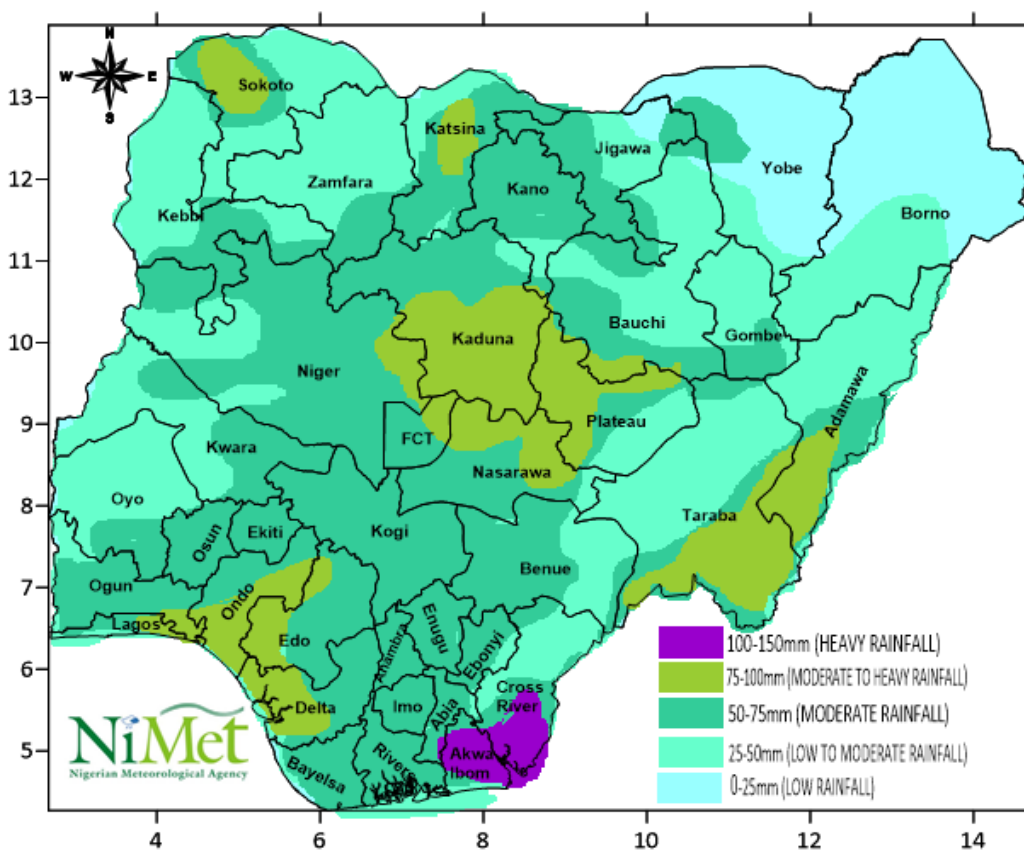


FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

2.1 Maximum Temperature

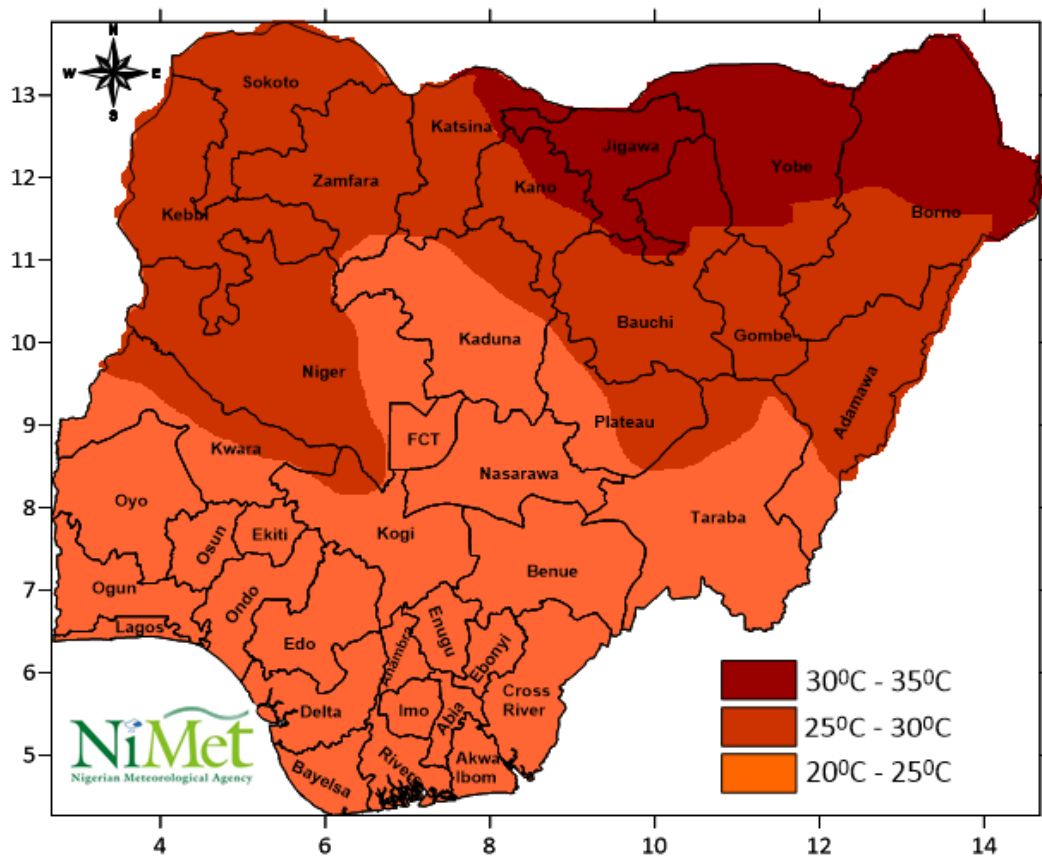


FIGURE 2: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Maximum Temperature range of 30 – 35°C is anticipated over parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa, Kano and Katsina states. Temperature range of 25 – 30°C is expected over Sokoto, Kebbi, Zamfara, Bauchi, Gombe, Adamawa, parts of Kaduna, Plateau, Kwara, Kogi and Niger states. Temperatures range of 20 – 25°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country. See Figure 2.

2.2 Minimum Temperature

Minimum temperature range of 25°C and above is expected over parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto and Kebbi states. Temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country with exception of parts of Kaduna, Kano, Bauchi, Plateau, Taraba and Adamawa states where temperature range of 15 - 20°C is expected. 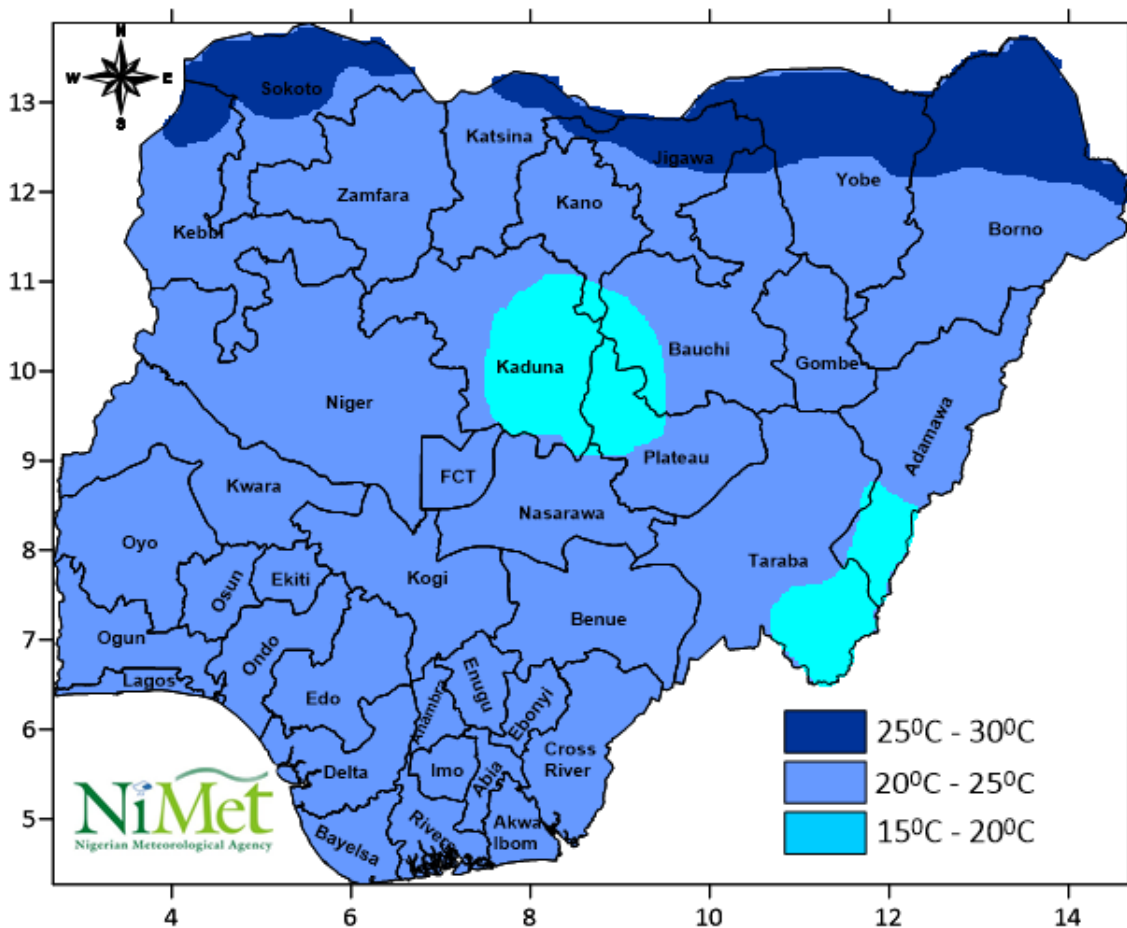


FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.
