REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) signal is expected to stay weak over the West African region. However, good moisture influx and favourable 200hPa velocity potential anomaly are expected to enhance the prospects of **Moderate rainfall** over parts of Cross River, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states. **Low to Moderate** rainfall is expected over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Ebonyi, Abia, Rivers, Imo, Bayelsa, Delta, Edo, Ondo, Lagos, Anambra and Ogun states while **Low rainfall** is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

Advisory: There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions; do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.

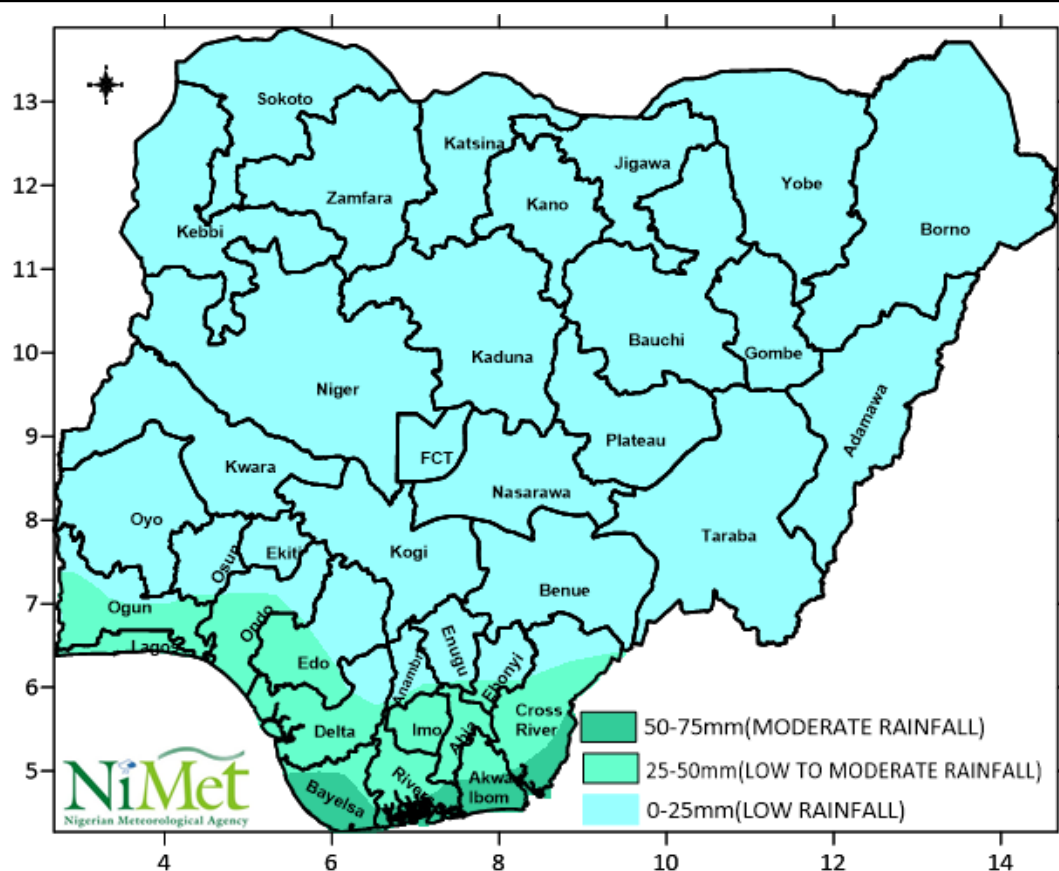


FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

2.1 Maximum Temperature

Maximum Temperature range of 35 – 40°C is anticipated over Borno, Yobe, Gombe, Jigawa, Kano, Sokoto, Kebbi, Parts of Zamfara, Niger, Kwara, Nasarawa, Katsina, Taraba, Kaduna, Kogi, FCT, Bauchi, Plateau and Adamawa states. Temperatures range of 30 – 35°C is expected over the south region of the country. Temperatures range of 25 – 30°C is expected over parts of Taraba, Akwa Ibom Rivers, Rivers and Bayelsa states. 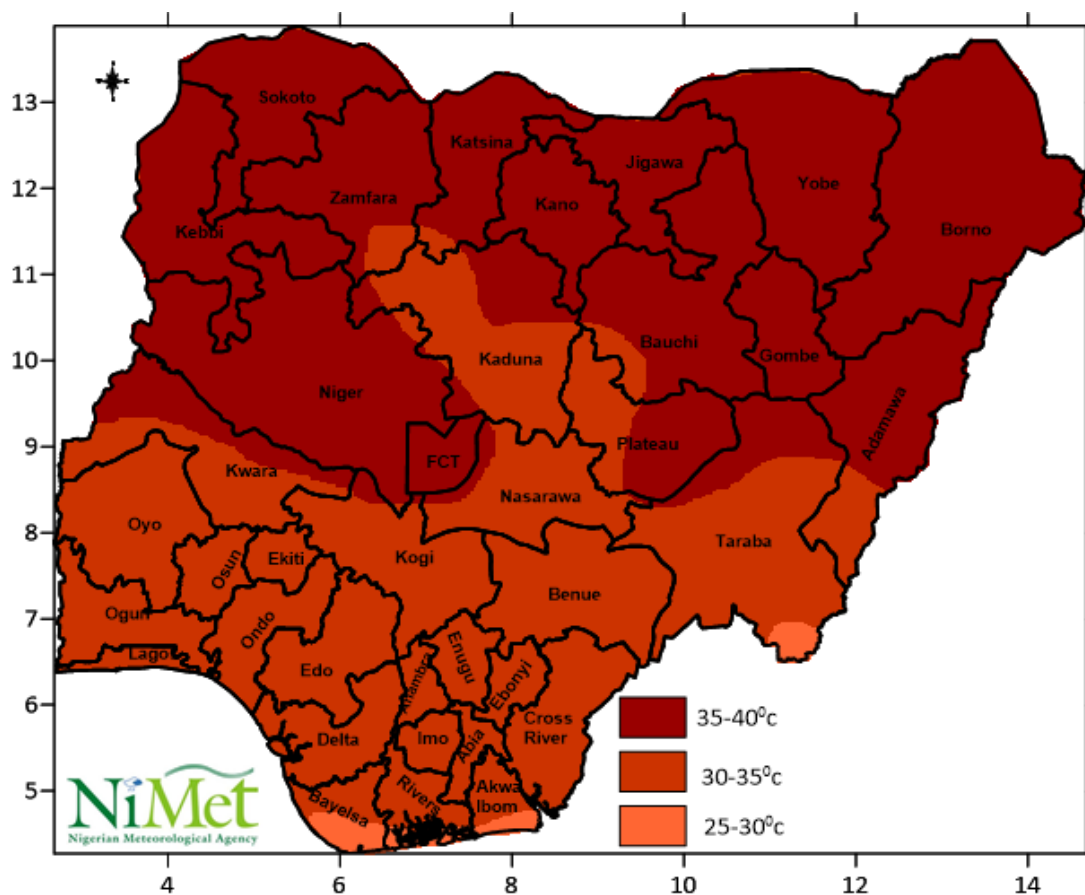


FIGURE 2: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

2.2 Minimum Temperature

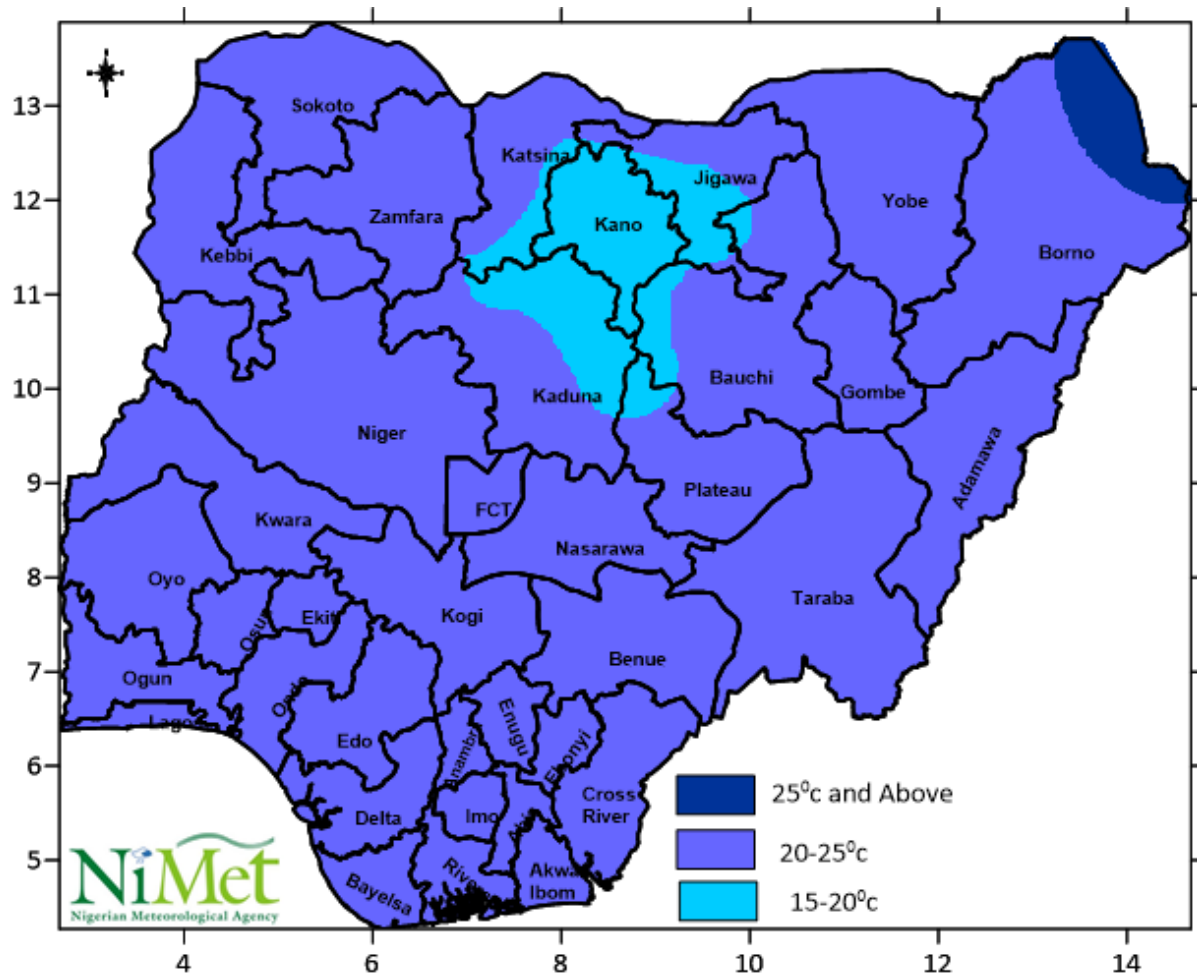


FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Minimum temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over most parts of the country. Temperature range of 15 - 20°C is expected over parts of Kano, Plateau, Jigawa, Bauchi, Kaduna and Katsina states. The remaining parts of the country should expect temperatures of 25°C and above. See Figure 3.
