

# **Weather Outlook**

# Day 1: Saturday 15th November, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 1-3km is expected across the region with prospects of localised visibility of less or equal to 1km over parts of Kano, Jigawa, Yobe, Borno and Katsina states during the forecast period.

#### **Central Region:**

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

## **Southern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Edo, Ondo, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Bayelsa and Delta states.

# Day 2: Sunday 16th November, 2025.

#### **Northern Region:**

Thick dust haze is expected across the region during the forecast period.

#### **Central Region:**

Sunny skies in hazy atmosphere are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

#### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Edo, Ondo, Bayelsa, Rivers and Delta states.

## Day 3: Monday 17th November, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

Thick dust haze is expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

## **Central Region:**

Sunny skies in hazy atmosphere are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

#### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region in the morning period. Isolated thunderstorms with Light rains are anticipated over parts of Abia, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

## **Advisory**

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. Dust particles are in suspension over the Northern region; public should take necessary precaution.
- iii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
