



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Sunday 16th November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 1-3km is expected across the region with prospects of localised visibility of less or equal to 1km over parts of Kano, Bauchi, Dutse, Yobe, Borno, Gombe, and Katsina states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate dust is anticipated over the North Central while Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over parts of Kogi, Benue and Kwara states throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Southern Ogun, Lagos, Bayelsa and Delta states.

Day 2: Monday 17th November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 1-3km is expected across the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 1 – 3km is anticipated over the region while parts of Kogi, Benue and Kwara state are expected to be in cloudy condition with sunny interval throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Tuesday 18th November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze with visibility range of 2 – 5km is expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region in the morning period. Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Akwa Ibom, Abia, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. Dust particles are in suspension over the Northern region; public should take necessary precaution.
- iii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
