Day 1: Thursday 20th November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with hazy atmosphere are expected over the Northen region during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over parts of Kwara, Kogi and Benue states in the morning hours, while the region is expected to be under sunny skies throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Bayelsa and Delta states.

Day 2: Friday 21st November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected across the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over parts of Kwara, Kogi and Benue states in the morning hours, while the region is expected to be under sunny skies throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Delta states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Saturday 22nd November, 2025.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over parts of Kwara, Kogi and Benue states in the morning hours, while the region is expected to be under sunny skies throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region in the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Lagos states.

Advisory

- i. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- ii. Dust particles are in suspension over the Northern region; public should take necessary precaution.
- iii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
