Day 1: Tuesday 9th December, 2025.

Northern Region:

Thick Dust Haze is anticipated over parts of Yobe, Gombe, Bauchi, Adamawa, Taraba, Borno and Jigawa states while the rest of the region is expected to experience Moderate Dust haze with visibility range of 2 - 5km throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate Dust haze with visibility range of 2 - 5km is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Rivers, Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Wednesday 10th December, 2025.

Northern Region:

Thick Dust Haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate Dust haze with visibility range of 2 - 5km is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Thursday 11th December, 2025.

Northern Region:

Moderate Dust haze with visibility range of 2 - 5km is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate Dust haze with visibility range of 2 - 5km is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Lagos, Edo, Ogun and Ondo states.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are in suspension over the Northern region; public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
