Day 1: Monday 5th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region with prospects of Moderate dust haze over parts of the Federal capital territory, Niger and Nasarawa states throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Bayelsa and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Tuesday 6th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the region during the forecast period

Central Region:

Sunny and Hazy conditions is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of thunderstorms with light rains over parts Akwa Ibom and Cross Rivers states during the afternoon/evening period.

Day 3: Wednesday 7th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the region during the forecast period

Central Region:

Sunny and Hazy conditions is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are anticipated over the region in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Ondo, Edo, Ogun, Bayelsa, Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are in suspension over the North central region; the public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
