Day 1: Tuesday 6th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are anticipated over the region in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Lagos, Ondo, Edo, Ogun, Bayelsa, Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states.
