Day 1: Friday 9th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over parts of Niger and the federal capital territory while the rest of the states would be under Sunny and hazy skies are expected over the region during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Saturday 10thJanuary, 2026.

Northern Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are expected over the region during the forecast period

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa state during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Sunday 11th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are anticipated over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light over parts Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the forecast period.
