Day 1: Tuesday 13th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated with prospects of thick dust haze resulting to visibilities of less than or equal to 1000m over Zamfara, Kano, Katsina and Jigawa states throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated over this region with chances of visibilities of less than or equal to 1000m over Niger and Federal capital territory.

Southern Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated over the inland cities of the southern region throughout the forecast period. Fog/mist is anticipated over the coastal region during the morning hours giving way to slight dust haze over the region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Wednesday 14th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated over this region throughout the forecast period with chances of visibilities of less than or equal to 1000m over Niger and Federal capital territory.

Southern Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated over the inland cities of the southern region while Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the coastal region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Cross River state during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Thursday 15th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Central Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the inland cities of the South, while Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the coastal region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Delta and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening hours

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are in suspension; the public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
