

## Weather Outlook

### **Day 1: Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2026.**

#### **Northern Region:**

*Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility of 2–5km is anticipated over the region with prospects of localized visibility of less than or equal to 1000m over parts of Katsina, Kano, Zamfara and Jigawa states anticipated throughout the forecast period.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Moderate dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Sunny skies with a few patches of cloud are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period with chances of early morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.*

### **Day 2: Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2026.**

#### **Northern Region:**

*Moderate dust haze is anticipated in the region throughout the forecast period.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Moderate dust haze is anticipated in this region during the forecast period.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Sunny skies with a few patches of cloud are anticipated over the region with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta and Lagos states.*

## **Day 3: Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2026.**

### **Northern Region:**

*Moderate dust haze is anticipated in the region throughout the forecast period.*

### **Central Region:**

*Moderate dust haze is anticipated in the region during the forecast period.*

### **Southern Region:**

*Partly cloudy skies with sunshine intervals are anticipated over the region with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate rain over parts of Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.*
