Day 1: Sunday 25th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze is anticipated over parts of Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Jigawa and Sokoto State during the forecast period while the rest of the northern region will be under sunny and hazy skies.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the Southwestern states, while few patches of clouds are anticipated over the Southeast with chances of isolated thunderstorms and light rains over parts of Bayelsa and Rivers state.

Day 2: Monday 26th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Jigawa and Sokoto State during the forecast period while the rest of the northern region will be under sunny and hazy skies.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are envisaged over the North Central region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the Southwestern states, while Sunny skies with few patches of clouds are anticipated over the Southeastern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms and light rains over Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers state.

Day 3: Tuesday 27th January, 2026.

Northern Region:

Thick dust haze is anticipated over the Northern region during the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy skies are envisaged over the North Central region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the Southwestern states, while Sunny skies with few patches of clouds are anticipated over the Southeast with chances of isolated thunderstorms and light rains over Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers state.

- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
