Day 1: Sunday 1st February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over parts of Kaduna and Taraba states while the remaining parts of the region are expected to experience sunny and hazy atmosphere throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger and Plateau states while the remaining parts of the region are expected to experience sunny and hazy atmosphere throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with a few patches of cloud are anticipated over the region with prospects of early morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Lagos, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Edo, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Rivers states.

Day 2: Monday 2nd February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny and hazy atmosphere is anticipated over the Northern region during the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy atmosphere is anticipated over the Northern region during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with a few patches of cloud are anticipated over the region with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Lagos, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Edo, Ekiti, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Rivers states.

Day 3: Tuesday 3rd February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny and hazy atmosphere is anticipated over the Northern region during the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy atmosphere is anticipated over the North Central region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with few patches of clouds are expected over the Southern region with likelihood of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Rivers, Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are in suspension; the public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
