Day 1: Saturday 14th February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region within the forecast period with chances of isolated thunderstorms and light rains over parts of Kogi State during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the Southern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms along with light rains over parts of Cross River, Rivers and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Ogun, Ondo, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Ekiti, Edo, Lagos Bayelsa, Delta, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Lagos states.

Day 2: Sunday 15th February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny atmosphere is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are envisaged over the North central region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine intervals is anticipated over the Southern region with prospects of thunderstorms and light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Cross River, Rivers and Delta state during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Ondo, Ogun, Osun, Oyo, Abia, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Lagos and Bayelsa states.

Day 3: Monday 16th February, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny atmosphere is anticipated over the Northern region during the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are anticipated over the region during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the Southern region with prospects of thunderstorms and light rains over parts of Lagos, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Anambra, Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Osun, Ekiti, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states.

Advisory

- i. Temperatures are expected to remain high thus thermal discomfort is expected to continue. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
- ii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
