Day 1: Sunday 1st March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze is expected over Katsina, Kano, Kaduna, Bauchi, Jigawa and Kebbi states, while the remaining parts of the region will experience slight dust haze throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Lagos, Ogun, Delta, Bayelsa, Ondo, Cross River and Edo states.

Day 2: Monday 2nd March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Ogun, Oyo, Bayelsa, Lagos, Delta and Cross River states.

Day 3: Tuesday 3rd March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated across the region within the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated across the region within the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the southern region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are anticipated over parts of Lagos, Oyo, Delta, Ogun, Bayelsa, Edo and Cross River states.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are in suspension over the Northern region and North Central region; the public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
