

**REMARKS 1.0 Rainfall**

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) signal is expected to stay weak over the West African region. However, with moisture influx, prospects of **Low Rainfall** are expected over parts Imo, Anambra, Abia, Ekiti, Osun, Ogun, Oyo, Ondo, Edo, Delta, Lagos, Cross River, Bayelsa and Rivers states, while **Low or no rainfall** is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

**Advisory:**

There is no anticipated risk of flooding. The public is however advised to watch out for updates.




**FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.**

### 2.1 Maximum Temperature

Maximum Temperature range of 30 – 35°C is anticipated over parts of Katina, Kano, Jigawa, Borno, Bauchi, Gombe, Kaduna, Plateau, parts of Zamfara and Kebbi state. Temperatures range of 35 – 40°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country. See Figure 2.

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## 2.2 Minimum Temperature




FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

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

Minimum temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over most parts of the country while temperature range of 15 - 20°C is expected over Katsina, Kano, Kaduna, Jigawa, Bauchi, Yobe, Gombe, Borno, Plateau, parts of Zamfara, Sokoto and Kebbi states. See Figure 3.
