Day 1: Thursday 5th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Moderate dust haze is expected over parts of Jigawa, Kano, Katsina and Kebbi states while slight dust haze is anticipated over the rest of the region throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region throughout the forecast period with chances of early morning isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kwara state.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region with prospects of morning isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Oyo, Ogun and Lagos states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Oyo, Ondo, Ogun, Ondo, Bayelsa, Lagos, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Delta states.

Day 2: Friday 6th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is expected over the region throughout the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over the region with throughout the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region with prospects of afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Oyo, Ondo, Ogun, Bayelsa, Lagos, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Delta states.

Day 3: Saturday 7th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated across the region within the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Sunny and hazy atmospheres are anticipated across the region within the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the southern region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are anticipated over parts of Anambra, Imo, Bayelsa, Ekiti, Lagos, Ogun, Ondo, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Rivers states.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are still in suspension over the Northern region and North Central region. The public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the weather condition.
- iii. Driving under rain should be with caution.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
