Day 1: Thursday 12th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the northern region throughout the forecast period with chance of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna and Taraba state during the afternoon/evening period.

North Central Region:

In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kwara, Niger and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Edo, Ekiti, Oyo, Imo, Enugu, Abia, Anambra, Osun, Bayelsa, Rivers, Ondo, Ogun, Lagos, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Friday 13th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the northern region with chance of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna and Taraba state during the afternoon/evening period.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated across the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Niger, Benue, Kwara and Kogi states.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. While, cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the rest of the Southern region. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of Oyo, Osun, Ekiti, Edo, Ondo, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Edo, Ogun, Lagos, Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 3: Saturday 14th March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the northern region with chance of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba state during the afternoon/evening period.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated across the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Niger, Kwara, Benue, Plateau, and Kogi states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region, with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of Osun, Ogun, Ondo, Edo, Oyo, Ekiti, Imo, Enugu, Abia, Anambra, Lagos, Cross River, Rivers, Bayelsa, Delta and Akwa Ibom states.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.

- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to be on the increase which may lead to thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
- vii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
