Day 1: Saturday 4th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with Patches of clouds are expected with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba state during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Kaduna and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are anticipated over the region in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of Kogi, Federal Capital Territory and Benue states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over the entire region.

Day 2: Sunday 5th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected with prospects of morning thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Taraba state in the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa and Taraba state.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms along with moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Kogi, Benue and Nasarawa states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunny intervals is anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with rains over parts of Lagos, Rivers, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected across the southern region.

Day 3: Monday 6th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the northern region during morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over Kwara, Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Kogi, Benue and Nasarawa states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunny intervals is anticipated over the region with prospects of thunderstorms with rains over parts of Oyo, Lagos, Ogun and Ondo states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire southern region.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
