Day 1: Monday 20th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the region during the morning. Thunderstorms without rain are expected over parts of Taraba state during the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours with slim chances of early morning thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Niger and Kwara states. There are prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kwara, Benue and Kogi states, while thunderstorms without rain are expected over parts of Niger, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Oyo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Abia, Osun, Ekiti, Anambra, Ondo, Edo, Imo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Cross River, Lagos, Ogun, and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Tuesday 21st April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region during the morning hours. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Taraba state in the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. There are chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Kwara, Benue, Kogi, and Nasarawa states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Oyo, Ogun, Ekiti, Osun, Ondo, Edo, Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Anambra, Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 3: Wednesday 22nd April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are expected over the region throughout the forecast period. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states in the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region during the morning. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Nasarawa, Benue, Kogi, the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Kwara and Plateau states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Anambra, Edo, Osun, Ogun, Ekiti, Lagos, Ondo, Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
