Day 1: Wednesday 29th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Slight dust haze is anticipated over parts of Borno, Yobe, Kano, Katsina, Bauchi and Jigawa states with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Kaduna states during the afternoon and evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Kwara, Nasarawa, Kogi, the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau and Niger states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Ondo, Oyo, Osun, Ogun, Imo, Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Rivers states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Thursday 30th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny and hazy atmosphere is anticipated over parts of Borno, Yobe, Kano, Katsina, Bauchi and Jigawa states with prospects of thunderstorms over southern Taraba during the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region during the morning hours. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Niger, Benue, Kwara and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region in the morning hours. There are prospects of widespread thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over the entire southern region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day Friday 1st May, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorm over parts of Taraba state during the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kogi and Benue states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of scattered thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Ogun and Lagos states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Dust particles are envisaged over the Northern region; the public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the expected weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- vi. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
- viii. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
