



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Thursday 30th April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies is anticipated over the region with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Taraba state during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba, Adamawa and Kaduna states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Kwara, Kogi, the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Benue and Niger states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Lagos and Cross River states. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over the entire southern region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Friday 1st May, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny atmosphere is anticipated over the region with prospects of thunderstorms with light rain over southern Taraba during the forecast period.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region in the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over the entire parts of Oyo, Edo, Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day Saturday 2st May, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Southern Adamawa and Taraba states in the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of scattered thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Ondo, Ogun and Lagos states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
