Day 1: Friday 1ST MAY, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains are expected over parts of Taraba and Kaduna states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara and Niger states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Delta and Cross River states. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over the entire southern region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Saturday 2nd May, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny atmosphere is anticipated over the region with slim prospects of thunderstorms accompanied with light rain over southern Taraba during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms accompanied with light rains are expected over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Plateau and Nasarawa states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Imo, Cross River, Delta, Bayelsa and Abia states. Later in the day, there are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over the entire region.

Day Sunday 3rd May, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Southern Adamawa, Kaduna and Taraba states in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba, Southern Adamawa, Bauchi and Gombe states in the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Benue and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of scattered thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Ondo, Ogun and Lagos states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
