



Weather Outlook

Day 1: Monday 31st August, 2026.

Northern Region:

There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Kebbi, Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states, while the rest of the region will be under partly cloudy skies during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over the North-west and parts of Bauchi, Borno, Gombe, Adamawa and Taraba state.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Benue and Niger states. By the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Abia, Enugu, Ebonyi, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and the South-western states during the morning hours. Later in the day, moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

Day 2: Tuesday 1st September, 2026.

Northern Region:

Patches of clouds are expected over the region in the morning hours with chances of moderate rains over parts of Taraba state. Later in the day, Isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected across the region during the morning hours with chances of moderate rains over parts of Benue and Kwara states. By the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected across the region during the morning hours with chances of moderate rains over the South-east, parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, moderate rains are expected over the South-east, South-south and parts of Oyo state.

Day 3: Wednesday 2nd September, 2026.

Northern Region:

Patches of clouds are expected over the entire region during the morning hours. Later in the day, scattered thunderstorms are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Gombe and Bauchi states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy skies are expected across the region with chances of morning rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger and Kwara states. By the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi, Plateau, Kwara, Niger and Benue states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected across the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, there are good chances of moderate rains over the Southeast and South-south regions while the remaining parts of the south should be cloudy with intervals of sunshine.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
